

# **Elstead Parish Council (EPC) Community Resilience Plan**

**Protecting and supporting our Village** 

# **Scope**

The Parish Councils primary role in any emergency is to support and advise the emergency response authority, Waverley Borough Council (WBC) and/or Surrey County Council (SCC), who will collaboratively decide who should take the lead in any incident.

This plan replaces the Parish council's previous Emergency Plan and has dissolved the voluntary group known as the Elstead Emergency Response (EER).

This plan is intended to support any of the following primary scenarios:-

#### Pandemic

- Danger to life reported by expert bodies
- Declared by Government
- Status communicated through local authorities

## • Fire or Flood

- o Emergency reported by member of the public
- Declared by emergency services
- Status communicated through local authorities

# Utility Failure


- Incident reported by member of the public
- Declared by utility providers
- Status communicated through local authorities

#### Local Hazard

- Issue/threat reported by member of public
- Status communicated through local authorities

This plan is approved by Elstead PC and may be triggered by any councillor or member of the public however overall responsibility in all situations belongs with WBC or SCC.

# **Process Stages**

#### Response Triggered

- Receive request to support local authority or resident(s)
- PC activates EPC Community Resilience Plan

#### Assess Impact

- Complete WBC Methane Template
- Notify WBC Command and control
- Confirm local risks and associated actions (SCC Community Risk Register)

### • <u>Co-ordinate Resource - iterative step</u>

- Identify and engage appropriate resources
  - WBC and SCC emergency planning officers (EPO)
  - Elstead Parish Councillors
  - Waverley Borough Councillors
  - Surrey County Council Councillors
  - Volunteers
  - Religious bodies
  - Help in Elstead (support when required)

# Maintain Communication – iterative step

- Update Village Website
- Post updates on village Facebook page
- Update Village News magazine
- Create and update Posters & Leaflets
- Maintain continuous contact with WBC and SCC EPO's

# • Capture Lessons Learned

• Complete WBC Template

# **Elstead Parish Council Responsibilities**

- Assessing the impact severity and associated risks
- Consulting with local authorities on need to action immediate emergency response.
- Identifying community problems and vulnerabilities
- Acting as the point of contact to villagers and local authorities (as required)
- Providing support to first responders
- Actioning local authority and emergency service requests
- Co-ordinating local resources to address any issues which do not pose a danger to life
- Providing cohesive community communications
- Capturing Lessons Learned
