TM/2022/03143	GREENWAYS PEAT COMMON ELSTEAD GODALMING GU8 6DX	Application for works to and removal of trees subject of tree preservation order wa297 Elstead Parish Council supports this application. The tree in question causes quite a lot of issues to neighbouring properties.
WA/2022/03159	TIT WILLOW HAM LANE ELSTEAD GODALMING GU8 6HG	Erection of an ancillary outbuilding Elstead Parish Council does not support this application and would highlight that the application cannot be made under permitted development rules. Elstead Parish Council would request that if planning officers were minded to approve this application a condition should be

applied whereby the proposed building remains ancillary to the main dwelling and that it does not form additional habitable accommodation. The site has been in effect sectioned off and has a gated side entrance and Elstead Parish Council would draw the planning Officers attention to the Elstead Village Design Statement which references that there should be a discouragement against back garden development.
